COVID-19 Testing in Rhode Island

If you have Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) symptoms, get tested.

COVID-19 symptoms include:

- cough
- trouble breathing
- fever or chills
- muscle or body aches
- sore throat
- headache
- nausea or vomiting
- diarrhea
- runny nose or stuffy nose
- being very tired
- recent loss of taste or smell

Call a healthcare provider or visit health.ri.gov/covid/testing to find a place to get tested.

- You can get tested for free at many places, even if you don't have insurance. Your immigration status doesn't matter.
- You can walk up to get tested at many places.
- Call first to make an appointment.

If you don't have COVID-19 symptoms, you could still have COVID-19 and pass it to others.

- Many people can get tested even if they do not have symptoms.
- To see if you can schedule a test, visit portal.ri.gov.
